



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

1 June 2018

PILING AND ROCK REMOVAL DURING JUNE

Piling to create retention walls for West Village Stage 2 infrastructure will progress along the site's Mollison Street boundary this fortnight while the removal of the quartz rockbed continues.

The extremely hard nature of the rock means it has to be broken up by rock breakers, rather than excavated by earthmoving machinery.

Rock-breaking will create additional noise and vibration, which will be maintained within the safe limits required by law.

There will be additional noisy work with jackhammers to remove concrete at the Boundary Street end of the site for the construction of the new public park called Mollison Green.

We apologise for any discomfort during these necessary operations.

The pedestrian footpath west of the City Glider bus stop on Mollison Street has been closed and will remain closed for the duration of the works.

West Village will construct a new public footpath, that is wider, smooth and even with the completion of the car park.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council.

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.

Traffic control will also remain in Mollison Street as required for the safety of workers, motorists and pedestrians.
