



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

15 June 2018

BULK EARTHWORKS TO BEGIN NEAR BOUNDARY STREET

Piling will continue at the Boundary Street end of the West Village site this fortnight before bulk earthworks begin to excavate new basement car parking.

The removal of earth and the hard quartz rockbed from the western (Bank Street) end remains ongoing and will require the use of rock breakers at various times.

Rock-breaking will create additional noise and vibration, which will be maintained within the safe limits required by law.

Works to construct Boundary Street Common – one of two public parks West Village will provide – will also begin this fortnight. Access to this area of the site will be from Boundary Street, and traffic control will be in place as required to manage the safe movement of workers, motorists and pedestrians.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council.

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.

Traffic control will also remain in Mollison Street as required for the safety of workers, motorists and pedestrians.
