



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

16 August 2018

WESTERN EARTHWORKS NEAR COMPLETION

Bulk earthworks at the western (Bank Street) end of the West Village site are nearing completion as work ramps up in the east of the site (near Boundary Street) to remove the quartz rockbed.

The extremely hard nature of the rock means it has to be broken up by rock breakers, rather than excavated by earthmoving machinery.

Rock-breaking will create additional noise and vibration, which will be maintained within the safe limits required by law. We apologise for any discomfort during this necessary operation.

As mentioned in the last construction notice, the footpath along the site's frontage (southern side of Mollison Street) has been closed from the CityGlider bus stop to West Village's western boundary.

This footpath will be replaced at the completion of the works with a new, wider, footpath that is smooth and even.

Locals are asked to use the signalised pedestrian crossing at the corner of Mollison and Boundary streets and the footpath along The Markets frontage to safely navigate Mollison Street.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council.

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
