



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

CARPARK EXCAVATION NOW 70% COMPLETE

The construction of the basement car parking continues to schedule despite the wet weather over the last fortnight, and excavation is now 70% complete.

Activity at the western (Bank Street) end of the site remains focused on concrete pours and the installation of pre-cast concrete columns, while bulk earthworks are ongoing in the centre sector.

Site access from Mollison Street will continue to move up and down the street through November to best fit the needs of the works. Traffic control will be in place as required for the safety of all.

THE COMMON PARKLAND DELIVERED

Works to deliver The Common have now been completed. The new urban park, two new laneways and three eateries, are now open to the public.

Wilson Lane provides a new pedestrian connection to Wilson Street from the Peters Ice Cream Factory.

Boundary Street footpath upgrades are now complete and the new, widened footpath is open to the public. The permanent location of the bus stop (Boundary St at West End Junction, stop 5), will be determined by Brisbane City Council.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council.

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
