



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

EXCAVATION WORKS CONTINUE TO SCHEDULE

The excavation of the remainder of the West Village site to construct the future residential stages, the public car park and the retail centre continues as planned and approved.

Work this month will focus on concrete pours to build Stage 2's basement car parking at the Bank Street end, and bulk earthworks in the centre of site for Stage 3 and the underground public car park.

Site access from Mollison Street will continue to move up and down the street through November to best fit the needs of the works. Traffic control will be in place as required for the safety of all.

CONSTRUCTION OF THE SENSORY GARDEN

This month we are commencing construction of the final area of The Common, which will add a sensory garden to the new public green space. The sensory garden is designed to provide opportunities to stimulate the senses and will have a wide range of educational and recreational applications.

From Monday 12th November access via the cobblestone laneway into West Village from Boundary Street will be affected. From Monday 19th November a small section of the Boundary Street footpath will be closed to facilitate this construction.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council. **However, in response to community feedback, when possible no rock breaking will occur before 7am.**

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
