



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

CRANE ASSEMBLY AND MOLLISON STREET CLOSURE

Damage to the crane during transit unfortunately delayed the installation of the second tower crane last weekend.

This crane will support the construction of the central residential and retail car parking structure, and for worker safety will be erected outside of the excavation area on Mollison Street – requiring a full street closure between Bank and Boundary Streets.

The street closure permit for Mollison Street is in place from 12pm Friday 1st February until 5am Monday 4th February.

Traffic control will be in place at all times to ensure resident access is maintained.

Pedestrian access along The Markets Shopping Centre side of the street will remain unchanged.

To minimise out-of-hours noise disruption to Mollison street residents, the 450 tonne mobile crane needed to erect the larger tower crane will be set up on Mollison Street from 12pm on Friday 1st February. This is expected to be completed by 7pm.

Whilst no works are scheduled to take place overnight, the road closure and traffic control will remain in place.

From 6:30am to 5:30pm Saturday 1st February the tower crane will be erected on Mollison Street. Following this, the mobile crane will be demobilised. This is expected to be completed by midnight.

Every effort will be made to reopen Mollison Street as soon as possible following demobilisation, and by no later than 5am on Monday 4th February.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Bulk and detailed excavation activity will continue between 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council.

Delivery and removal of large equipment may occur outside of these hours as required by the Department of Main Roads (note: removal of some large equipment is scheduled for Wednesday 2nd February at 5am).

The project endeavours not to undertake rock breaking before 7am.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.

The daily cleaning/street sweeping of Mollison Street that was implemented at the end of last year will continue throughout January.
