



WEST VILLAGE ONE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

SITE PREPARATIONS TO CONTINUE

The building at 37 Mollison Street was demolished on 3 August in accordance with approvals issued by Brisbane City Council.

Minor works will continue across the site ahead of bulk earthworks starting Monday 15 August.

The earthworks will create the building pad and the level for the basements of the two buildings that will be built along West Village's Wilson Street frontage.

Covered trucks will be used to remove material from the site using the Mollison Street access.

There will be a minor increase in truck traffic at various times throughout the day.

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday in accordance with Brisbane City Council requirements.

Large equipment needed for the earthworks may be delivered to or removed from the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Management plans for the potential for dust and noise impacts on surrounding homes and businesses and erosion controls will continue to be implemented.
