EARTHWORKS TO CONTINUE, NEW ENVIRONMENTAL MEASURES

As indicated in the last construction update, earthworks to prepare for the construction of the buildings on West Village's Wilson Street frontage will continue into October.

These works will result in increases in heavy vehicle traffic to and from the site via Mollison Street throughout the day. Traffic controllers will be working when required to maintain safety.

A vehicle wash down bay is now in operation. The wash down bay restricts dust being tracked on to Mollison Street, and works in tandem with other site management tools such as water hoses and water trucks that wet the earth being excavated.

There are limits on how often water can be used before the ground turns to mud. To further reduce noise and dust, the project continues to bring in new equipment that can remove large pieces of rock or concrete found during excavation intact, instead of having to break these into smaller pieces.

WORKING HOURS AND EARLY DELIVERIES

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.

Large equipment needed for the earthworks may be delivered to or removed from the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
