EXCAVATION PROGRESSING WELL

Excavation work is progressing well, with completion expected as soon as early December.

Rock breakers continue to be required to break up the extremely hard quartz. However, the need for rock breaking is being minimised by removing rock from the site in pieces as large as possible.

The concentration of spoil removal to particular days will continue. This strategy means trucks are only required one or two days per week, and do not have to move outside the standard working hours (6.30am – 6.30pm).

WORK HOURS AND AUGMENTED CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.

Construction management plans are in place to minimise potential dust and noise impacts on surrounding homes and businesses, in accordance with Brisbane City Council (BCC) requirements.

Appropriate dust management procedures, including a vehicle wash down bay, will continue to be used to manage dust. BCC has conducted testing on the site and found dust levels are being managed well within allowable limits.

Large equipment may be delivered to or removed from the site via Mollison Street outside of the above times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads. Where possible, we will continue to notify Mollison Street residents in advance of these deliveries.
