



## **WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

**4 May 2018**

### **EXCAVATION ACTIVITY BUILDING OVER THE NEXT FORTNIGHT**

Piling will begin next week at the western end of the West Village site to create the retention walls for the car parking for Stage 2 of the development.

The start of removal of the quartz rockbed will also commence this fortnight.

The extremely hard nature of the rock means it has to be broken up by rock breakers, rather than excavated by earthmoving machinery.

Rock-breaking will create additional noise and vibration, which will be maintained within the safe limits required by law. We apologise for any discomfort during this necessary operation.

Both of these activities will see a minor increase in truck traffic at various times throughout the day.

### **WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT**

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday.

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.

Traffic control will also remain in Mollison Street as required for the safety of workers, motorists and pedestrians.
