



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

2 August 2018

PILING TO END AS EARTHWORKS MOVE FORWARD

Piling is expected to finish at the end of September as bulk earthworks continue across the remainder of the site to construct West Village Stages 2, 3 and 4, as well as the public car park and retail hub.

The footpath along the site's frontage (southern side of Mollison Street) will be closed this week from the CityGlider bus stop to the western end of West Village's boundary.

This footpath will be replaced at the completion of the works with a new, wider, footpath that is smooth and even.

The overhead power lines along the footpath have now been removed and power lines have been placed underground – improving visual amenity.

In the interim, the footpath will be secured with construction hoarding and managed by traffic control.

Locals are asked to use the signalised pedestrian crossing at the corner of Mollison and Boundary streets and the footpath along The Markets frontage to safely cross and navigate Mollison Street.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council.

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
