



WEST VILLAGE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

STAGE 2 CAR PARKING STRUCTURE NEARS GROUND LEVEL

The basement car parking for West Village Stage 2 (near Bank Street) continues to take shape, with concrete pours over the next fortnight/month to bring the parking structure close to level with Mollison Street.

Bulk earthworks will be ongoing in the centre and eastern (near Boundary Street) sectors of the site.

BOUNDARY STREET

On Boundary Street, works to upgrade the footpath along West Village's frontage will be completed and the area reopened to the public - subject to Brisbane City Council inspection and sign off.

The upgraded footpath provides a better and safer surface for pedestrians and new lighting, while keeping the existing street trees.

The creation of the sensory garden in The Common park off Boundary Street continues to schedule.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council. In response to community feedback, the project endeavours not to undertake rock breaking before 7am.

Large equipment may be delivered to the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
