CRANE ASSEMBLY AND MOLLISON STREET CLOSURE

Bad weather in the final working week of 2018 delayed the installation of the second tower crane that will support the construction of the central residential and retail car parking structure.

The crane will now arrive to site in the early hours of Saturday (19 January) and be assembled over the course of the weekend.

The level of excavation of the site means the crane has to be assembled from Mollison Street, requiring a full closure of the street between Bank and Boundary streets.

This activity has been approved by Brisbane City Council and Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Permits are in place to close Mollison Street from **7pm Friday 18 January until 5am Monday 21 January**.

Every effort will be made to safely complete the assembly and reopen Mollison Street to traffic as soon as possible.

Traffic control will be in place to maintain vehicle access for Mollison Street residents adjacent to the site. Pedestrian access along The Markets Shopping Centre side of the street will remain unchanged.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Bulk and detailed excavation activity will continue throughout January between 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday as approved by Brisbane City Council.

The project endeavours not to undertake rock breaking before 7am.

Measures such as water trucks and tyre wash down bays to manage the potential for dust impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.

The daily cleaning/street sweeping of Mollison Street that was implemented at the end of last year will continue throughout January.
