DEMOLITION WORKS TO FINISH THIS MONTH

The demolition of the site's non-heritage buildings will finish this month with the removal of the Freezer Building's concrete slab and the grading of demolished material for recycling.

As indicated in the last construction update, the removal of the Freezer Building's slab is an unusual process and has required the use of jackhammers to break up the two layers of concrete and their separating layer of rigid insulation.

We acknowledged the potential impact this activity may have on our neighbours and have used localised and whole of site watering to manage dust. These measures will continue.

The large piece of equipment on site to sieve and sort rubble into its recoverable parts also has internal water misters to suppress dust from this process.

The removal of the rubble from the site will continue until the end of July and will result in increased truck traffic at various times throughout the day.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday, and management plans for the potential for dust and noise impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
