DEMOLITION OF THE FREEZER ROOM NEARS COMPLETION

Work to remove the Freezer Building's structural columns and concrete slab is scheduled for completion within the next week, marking the end of a major phase of site activity.

The project intends to use heavy machinery to lift the concrete slab in large sections, however jackhammers may be required and if so will be noisy.

The removal of rubble from the site will continue until at least the middle of July and will result in increased truck traffic at various times throughout the day.

The heritage Peters Ice Cream factory and the warehouse fronting Wilson Street are being retained and will be restored by West Village as centrepieces of the development.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Working hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday, and management plans for the potential for dust and noise impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
