EXCAVATION AND INGROUND WORKS

We are nearing completion of in-ground works, which will reduce rock breaking on-site. We want to thank the community for their patience during this necessary work.

COMMENCEMENT OF SUSPENDED SLAB

Form, reinforcement and pouring of concrete will be the major activities over the coming months. You may notice construction works becoming more visible, as we move up from the basement level.

DELIVERIES

As we transition to a focus on forming/pouring of the columns and slabs, you may notice an increase in concrete truck movements and other deliveries to and from the site.

WORKFORCE

Workforce numbers are also increasing. We have a dedicated workforce carpark to reduce impacts on surrounding street parking. Dust mitigation strategies are also in place to manage the increased traffic.

WORK HOURS AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Work hours will continue to be 6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday (unless otherwise approved for specific purposes).

Large equipment may be delivered to or removed from the site via Mollison Street outside of these times, as required and permitted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

Management plans for the potential for dust and noise impacts on surrounding homes and businesses will continue to be implemented.
